<p><u>Hocus & Lotus – stories & info</u> Unit 1, formats 1-3</p> <p><u>Spanish Meetings</u> Spanish Meetings will introduce basic features of learning Spanish. There will be games, stories and songs teaching greetings, numbers, colours, animals and body parts. <i>NC - Pupils will be taught to listen attentively to a spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding. They will explore the patterns and sounds of language through songs and rhymes and link the spelling, sounds and meaning of words.</i></p>			
	<p><u>Hocus & Lotus – stories</u> Unit 1, formats 4-6</p> <p><u>Spanish Meetings</u> There will be games, stories and songs teaching weather, food and common expressions. There will be retrieval tasks from Stage 1. <i>NC – Pupils will develop their pronunciation and intonation and use familiar words and phrases more accurately. They will appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in Spanish.</i></p> <p><u>Duolingo</u> Each pupil is signed up to the school’s Duolingo account. This supports all pupils in their learning of Spanish, offering activities that improve pupils’ speaking, listening, reading and writing skills.</p>		
		<p><u>Hocus & Lotus – stories</u> Unit 2, formats 1-3</p> <p><u>Spanish Meetings</u> The meetings will consolidate all learning from previous stages and include family and friends, hobbies and school. <i>NC – Pupils will be able to express opinions and respond to others. They will broaden their vocabulary and develop their ability to understand new words that are introduced in a familiar context.</i></p> <p><u>Duolingo</u> Each pupil is signed up to the school’s Duolingo account. This supports all pupils in their learning of Spanish, offering activities that improve pupils’ speaking, listening, reading and writing skills.</p>	
			<p><u>Hocus & Lotus – stories and info</u> Year 5 – Unit 2, formats 4-6 Year 6 -Unit 3, formats 1-3</p> <p><u>Reading and Writing</u> <i>NC - Pupils will be taught how to read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing. They will be able to adapt phrases to create new sentences to express ideas clearly. They will be able to describe people, places, things and actions orally and in writing.</i></p> <p><u>Duolingo</u> Each pupil is signed up to the school’s Duolingo account. This supports all pupils in their learning of Spanish, offering activities that improve pupils’ speaking, listening, reading and writing skills.</p>

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In the Hocus and Lotus programme there are 5 units with 6 stories in each unit. Students will practise three stories each year (one each term). They will listen and act out the story, watch the video of the story, read the story and hear it read to them, and sing the story. In each immersive story students are exposed to a variety of grammatical structures including different verb tenses (present, imperfect, preterite). In each story they will learn new vocabulary which will be reinforced throughout the following stories. Through the first six stories there are a total of 276 different words and 1352 words altogether. These are broken down as follows:

As this is a new scheme of learning all children in the school will begin with Format 1 and learn 3 stories that year. The next year they will learn stories 4-6. The following year they will move on to the next unit. In the next few years we expect the progression to look as follows:
