
Our Key Principles

- The online safety of our children is paramount and GDPR is carefully managed.
- All pupils should have access to the same high quality standard and amount of education whether they are in school or at home.
- The core curriculum content is prioritised to ensure that pupils continue to make strong progress.
- A blended approach to teaching and learning underpins our curriculum design
- If a child is learning remotely from home, our expectation is that wherever possible, they follow the timetable sent by the class teacher

Allocated Time

- The remote education provided should be equivalent in length to the core teaching pupils would receive in school and will include both recorded or live direct teaching time, and time for pupils to complete tasks and assignments independently. The amount of remote education provided should be, as a minimum:
- Key Stage 1: 3 hours a day on average across the cohort, with less for younger children
- Key Stage 2: 4 hours a day
- Teachers will put weekly timetables on Google Classroom which will indicate timings and range of activities (see example on next page) These can be amended during the week to reflect changes

Activities, resources and videos will all be found within the Classwork section of Google Classroom, under the relevant day and date.




Read Write Inc.

Safeguarding

- Increased risks through remote teaching and learning we must manage these risks in order to continue to provide the educational offer that our children are entitled to.
- When teaching from within the classroom, teachers will only 'unmute' at appropriate times.
- It will be possible for children at home to see the children in the classroom at certain times, which really motivates the children at home.
- The safeguarding procedures apply to remote teaching and learning as they would do in school. Any issues will be logged / reported in the same way.
- Where 1:1 tutoring sessions are taking place remotely, a parent must be in the same room as the child
- GDPR: teachers will ensure that personal data is not shared remotely.
- Safeguarding training around remote learning to be done with staff imminently as a refresher
