There will be no hot lunches available but you may pre-order a grab bag via parent pay for children who have free School meals or are Universal Free School Meals (Rec, Y1 and Y2) but these must still be ordered. **Grab bags must be ordered before 8th July 2018.**

Children should still wear their school uniform, however as we will be walking through the woods, suitable footwear and sun hats/raincoats should be considered depending on the weather on the day. Year 2 and Year 4 should still come in their PE kits as they will have PE in the morning sessions.
