

Step 1: Launch Posters

It is proven that schools who use our promotional materials are more likely to get high parental uptake. It can take time to arrange printing and delivery of materials, so we recommend that you arrange for the relevant promotional materials available on this page to be produced at the outset, so they are ready in time for your launch to parents.

Use these materials to support your launch of ParentPay and for new pupil intakes...

Please note – these materials should only be displayed and distributed when parents are in a position to activate their accounts (Step 6), as they are designed to encourage parents to go onto ParentPay and use their new account activation login.



These materials can be used to support the launch of ParentPay but are designed to also be used at anytime after that. We recommend that materials are available at parent evenings, especially when communicating to parents of new intake pupils. You can download and print A3 size posters to display around parent facing areas of the school, we have also included A4 flyers which can be left in reception areas and sent home to parents alongside account activation letters.

All materials have Primary and Secondary versions specifically focused on either school meals, trips or a general one for schools offering more items for online payment through ParentPay.













What could you do to promote ParentPay to parents before launch?

To get parents ready, sending pre-launch letters to parents is always a good idea, you can access some examples in [Step 2 of this launch pack](#). We would also recommend texting or emailing parents a link to a news item about ParentPay on your website – why not adapt one of our example news items in [Step 3 of this launch pack](#).

Then follow up again and text/email parents when you are in a position for them to activate their accounts (Step 6 in this launch pack).

Step 2: Pre-launch Letters

Our pre-launch letters have been created in Microsoft Word so you can tailor them to precisely reflect what items you will be accepting payments for via ParentPay, and print them on your headed paper. The pre-launch letters also include frequently asked questions (FAQs) and the option of a reply slip for schools that will be offering over the counter cash payments using the PayPoint network at local convenience stores.

Our parent flyer will highlight the benefits of ParentPay to both you and your parents, further raising awareness of what you are aiming to achieve with the introduction of ParentPay. Before distributing the flyer – please edit and delete any information that is not relevant to your school. Feel free to tailor the flyer to your requirements and insert your logo. Use the flyer in combination with our other [promotional material](#), to remind existing parents and new intakes about your preferred payment method and the benefits of using your ParentPay service.
